Guide to easier documentation for 12th Raid-de-Himalaya, 2010

Urgent First Move –

1. Download the **Entry Form** & **Indemnity Form** available at the link below:

Fill up the available details on the Entry Form and email it to us. The rest can follow subject to deadline dates specified at the bottom of this document.

Indemnity Form

Buy Rs. 20/- stamp paper and take a print-out of the Indemnity Form on it. This needs to be attested by a magistrate or an Oath Commissioner

2. Deposit the **Entry Fee** – fax us the receipt in case of bank deposit or details of online transaction thru email – Bank Details on the link below -

Critical : By doing the above you ensure a place on the Raid. If you wait till all the paperwork is done to deposit the money you may find that no places are left.

Now that you have a place amongst the 2010 X-treme Moto/ Quad category – try and save money !!

On the Entry Form is a list of 11 documents (including the Indemnity mentioned above) the photocopies of which need to be submitted to **Himalayan Motorsport Association** –

1. Photocopy of **Riding/ Driving License** – all pages that show DL No., Name and Address, Place of Issue and the validity.
2. Photocopy of **FMSCI Competition License** – Download the 5 page application form from the link below -

New license applicants are eligible for Restricted License only (Fee Rs. 400/-)

For Full License – fee is Rs. 1000/-

Make sure to fill-up the Indemnity Form (Page 5 of the FMSCI application form)

This is not to be confused with the Indemnity Form mentioned under Article No. 10)

Mail these forms along with a **DD** for the requisite amount to FMSCI, Chennai at the earliest.

3. Photocopy of **Blood Group Report** – This is report from a pathology lab confirming your blood group type.

The blood group type, if specified on Driver's License, is also acceptable.

You need to send 1 copy to FMSCI also along with the License application so make enough photocopies.

4. Photocopy of **Personal Accident Insurance** (Heavy Risk) for a minimum amount of Rs. 2 Lakh. Ensure next of kin name is the same as you are giving to our office.

Mediclaime policies of similar amount are also acceptable in lieu of Personal Accident Insurance. Photocopy of Mediclaime Card is required and a copy of the policy showing cover for 2 lakhs or above.

5. Three Passport size Pictures + 3 stamp sized ones

Please write your name and Blood Group on the back of each picture with an alcohol permanent marker. Do not use ball pens as they smudge!

6. Photocopy of **Vehicle Insurance.**

7. Photocopy of **Vehicle Rally Insurance** – You would have to obtain this cover for your vehicle to compete in the Raid. It is an additional endorsement on the Comprehensive Insurance of the vehicle. This cover can ONLY be obtained from the same branch/ insurance co. that issued the Comprehensive insurance for your vehicle. This endorsement is generally for the duration of the event only. We recommend that this cover should cover from the 5th October, 2010 to the 20th October, 2010. This will include the days of the journey to-n-fro from your hometown.
8. Photocopy of **Registration Certificate of the motorcycle**
9. If you do not own the Vehicle, get an **Authorization Letter** from the owner – This Authority Letter should be on Rs. 10/- stamp paper and signed by a Magistrate. The letter should specify the owner’s name, vehicle no., engine and chasis no. and should state that the vehicle owner authorizes the competitor to use the vehicle for the **12th Raid-de-Himalaya, 2010**.
10. You are required to get a **Tread Mill Test (TMT)** done (with ECG) while exercising because of the endurance nature of the event to verify that the competitor is fit to run the Raid (FIM requirement)

The deadline for submission of documentation is exactly one month after the expiry date of Type of Entry you have put in –

Type of Entry	Valid from - to	Documentation Submission Deadline
Early	April 01 - May 15, 2010	June 15, 2010
Standard	May 16 - July 15, 2010	August 15, 2010
Late	July 16 - August 31, 2010	September 21, 2010
Very Late	Sep 01 – Sep 21, 2010	Immediately with Entry Fee

Non-compliance of the above deadlines will render your entry to be graduated to the next one and you end paying-up the differential amount.

e.g. You put in an early entry, however, were unable to file all the documentation by June 15th 2010. You will now be treated as a Standard Entry.

In that case, your deadline will be extended to July 15, 2010 and you will pay the differential amount between Early and Standard Entry i.e. Rs. 2500/-
